Covid restrictions (for restaurants)

Coronavirus entry pass (EU Certificate with QR Code) needed to show as a proof of vaccination in public places: restaurants, museums etc.

Health declaration (for flights)

If you are travelling by air you must fill in a health declaration (only when aged 13 or above) and carry it with you. Some airlines allow you to complete this health declaration digitally when you check in. If you want to fill in the health declaration on paper, print 2 copies. You will need one for your outbound flight and one for your return flight.

“Group tickets” **Only available online**, so order before you come.

The NS Group Ticket is only available online and costs €32 for 4 people with the possibility to add up to 3 more passengers for €1.50 per additional person.

The ticket is valid during off-peak hours: on weekdays until 6:30 am, between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm and after 6:30 pm. All day on weekends and public holidays.

You do not need to check in at the station with an e-ticket. If you are travelling to or from a station with closed gates, then go to a gate with a barcode reader and open it with the square code on the e-ticket. Keep your e-ticket until the exit of your destination station; it might be needed there too to open the gates.

Schiphol Airport is an open gate, Rotterdam Central Station is a closed gate.

Public transport chip card (needed for metro and tram; no need if we decide walking)

OV-chipkaart -Tourists(ov-chipkaart.nl)

Available at counter NS train station Schiphol Airport in the arrival hall or RET Service location in Rotterdam Central Station hall and in machines.

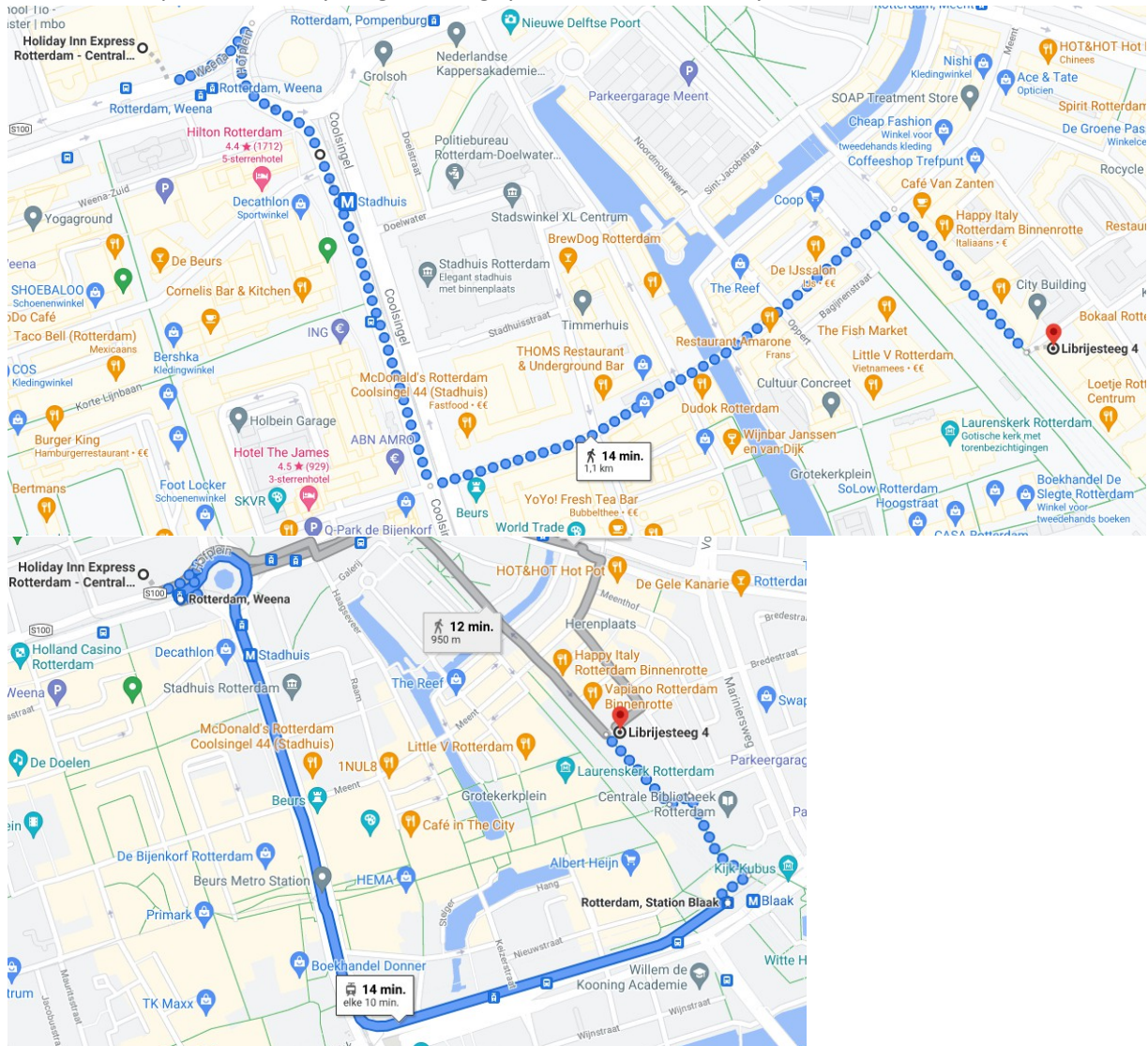
Cards can be reloaded in machines in all metro and train stations.

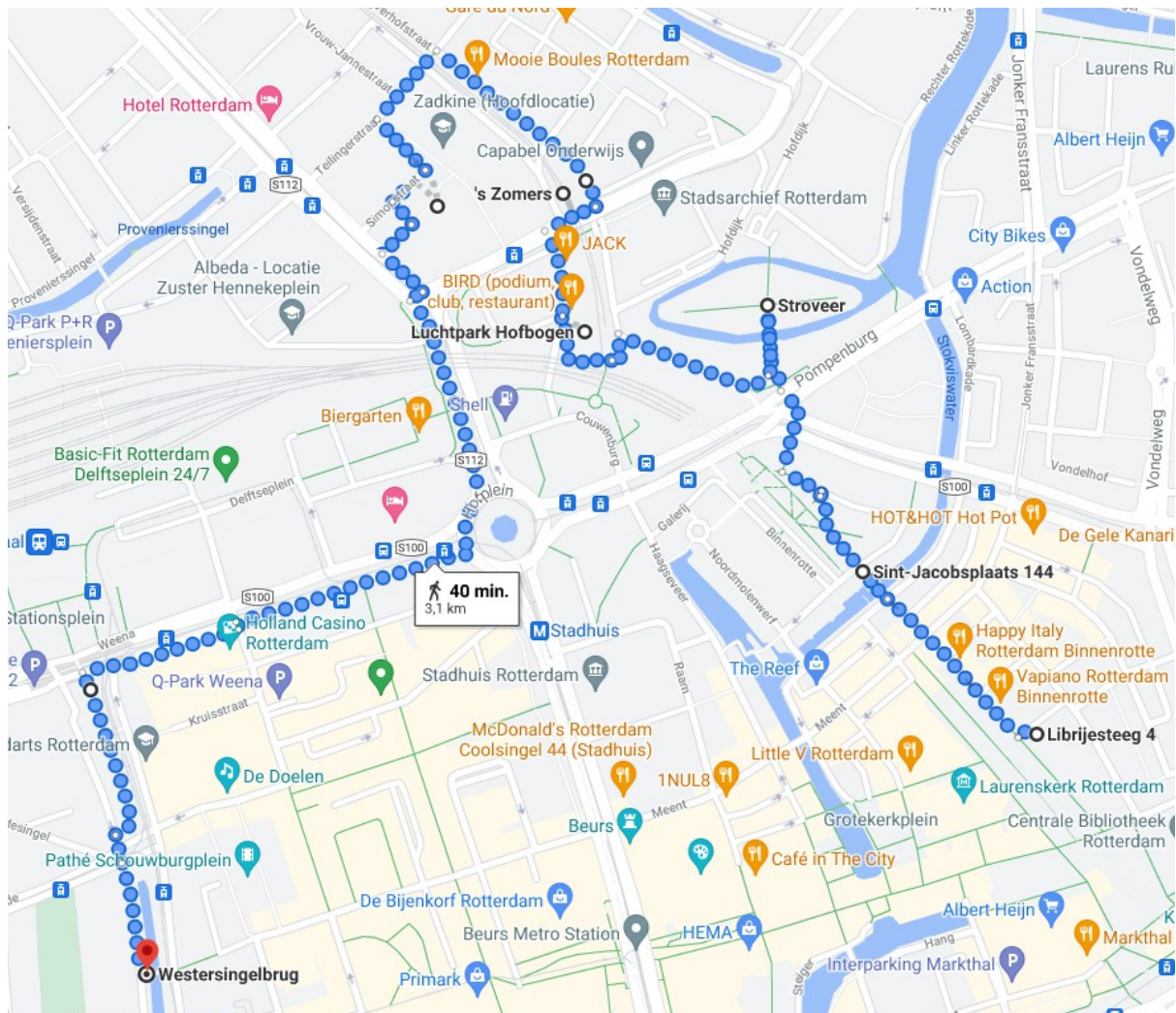
From Holiday Inn to Librijesteeg 4:

The market square is actually a sight seeing spot: the Central Library and the Market Hall are there.

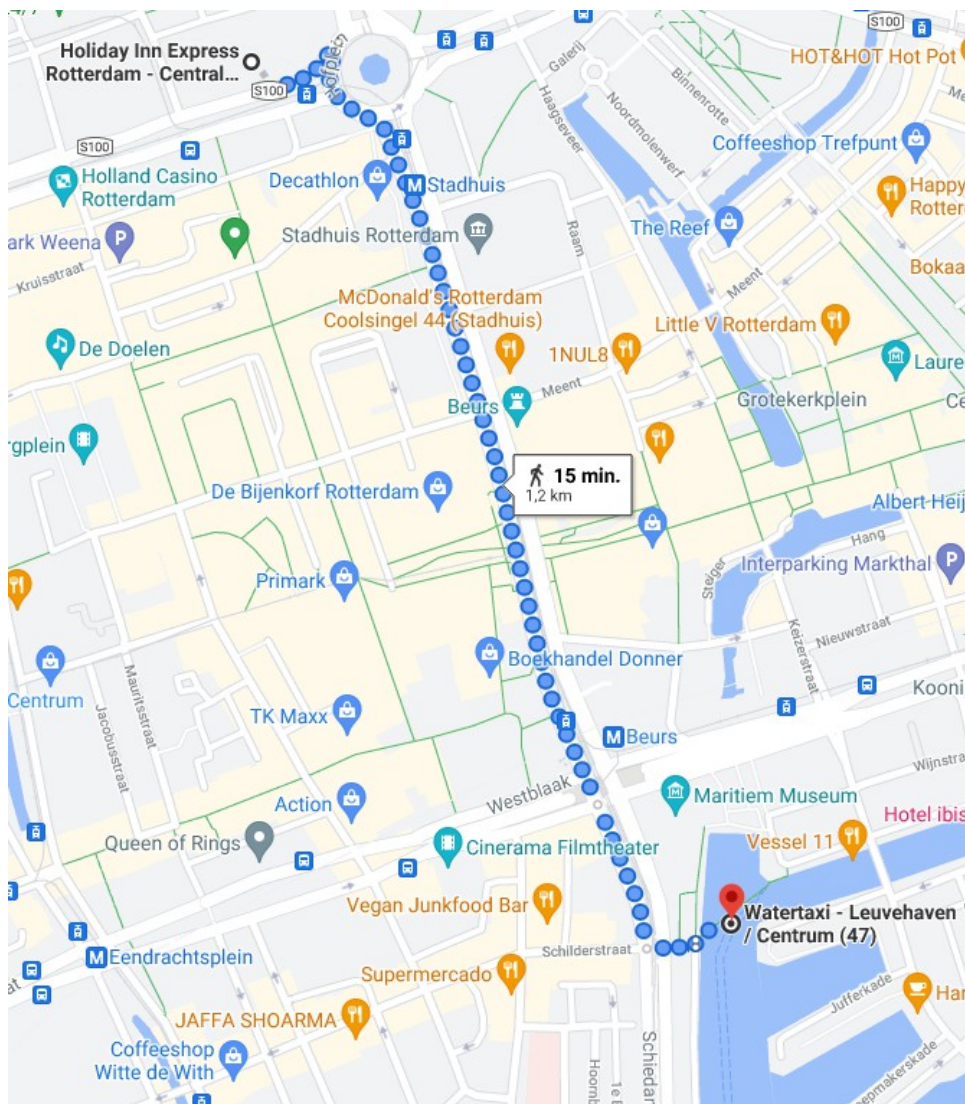

From Holiday Inn to Leuvehaven Watertaxi:

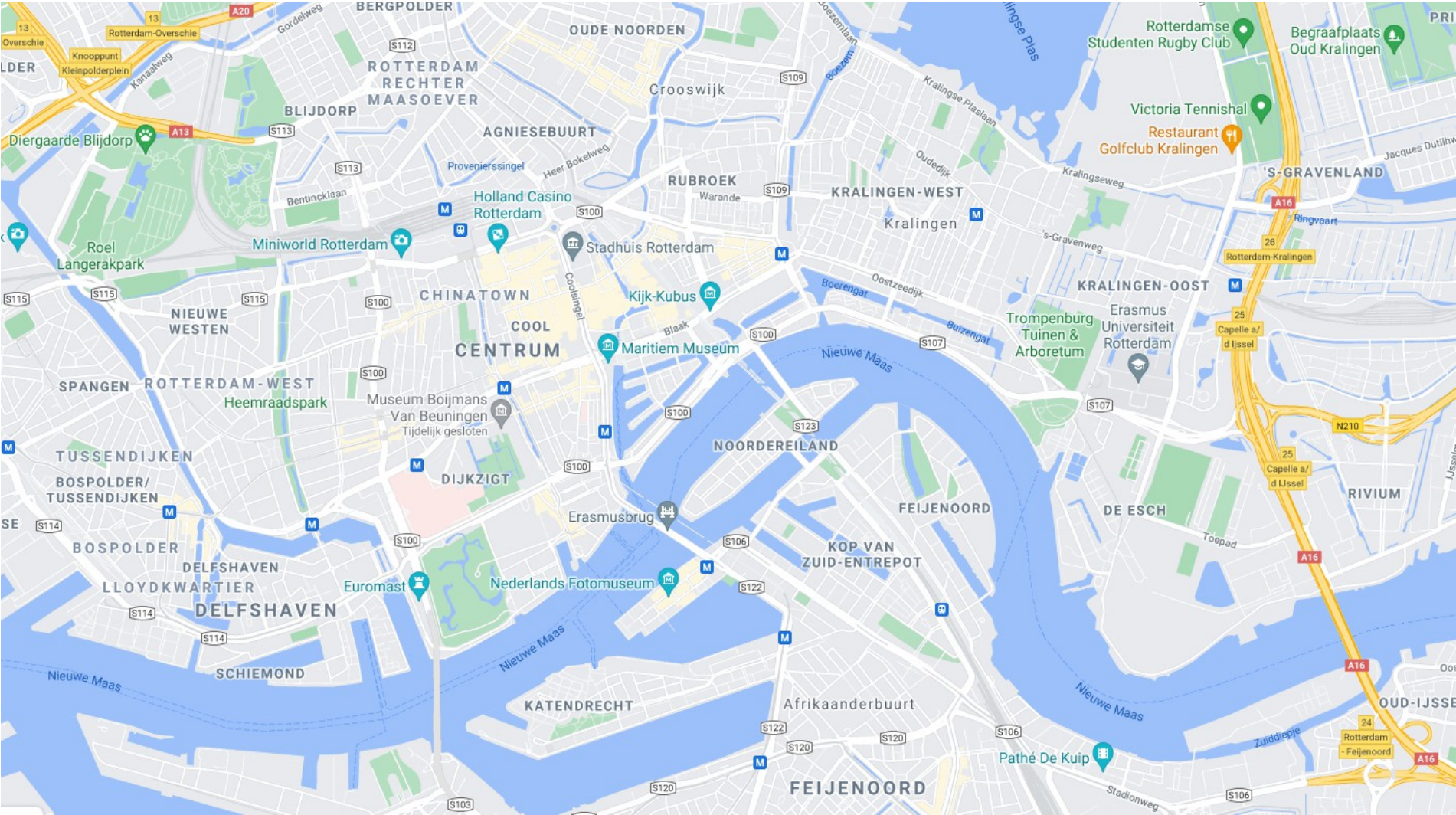
15 minute walk or 1 metro stop. Walk across the Coolsingel, cross the Westblaak and turn left after the Maritime Museum.

Metro: get in at Stadhuis and out at Beurs (Maritime Museum, they announce the stop).

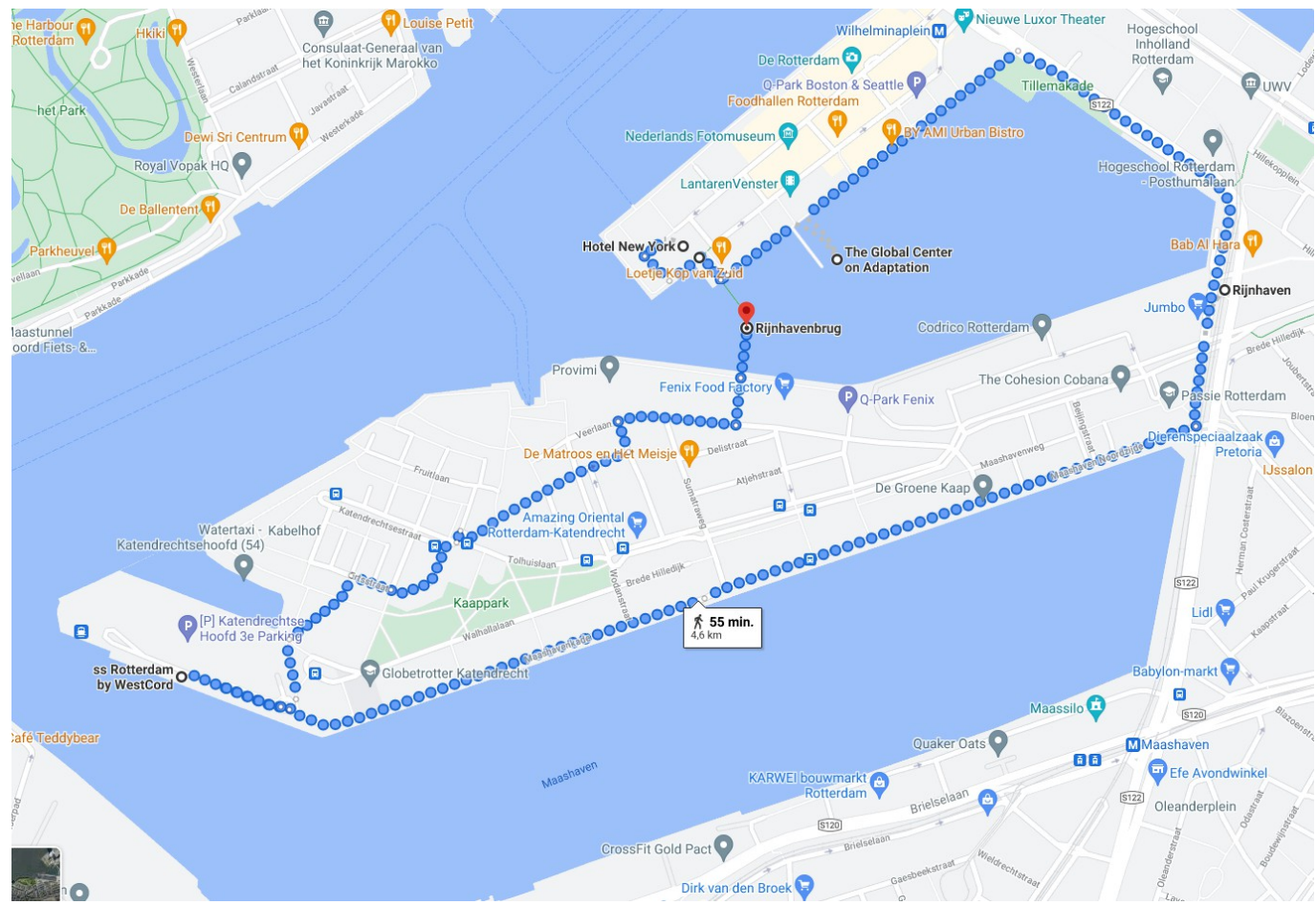
Tram: Line 21 or 24 (direction De Esch) at Weena (across the street at the hotel), get off at Beurs.

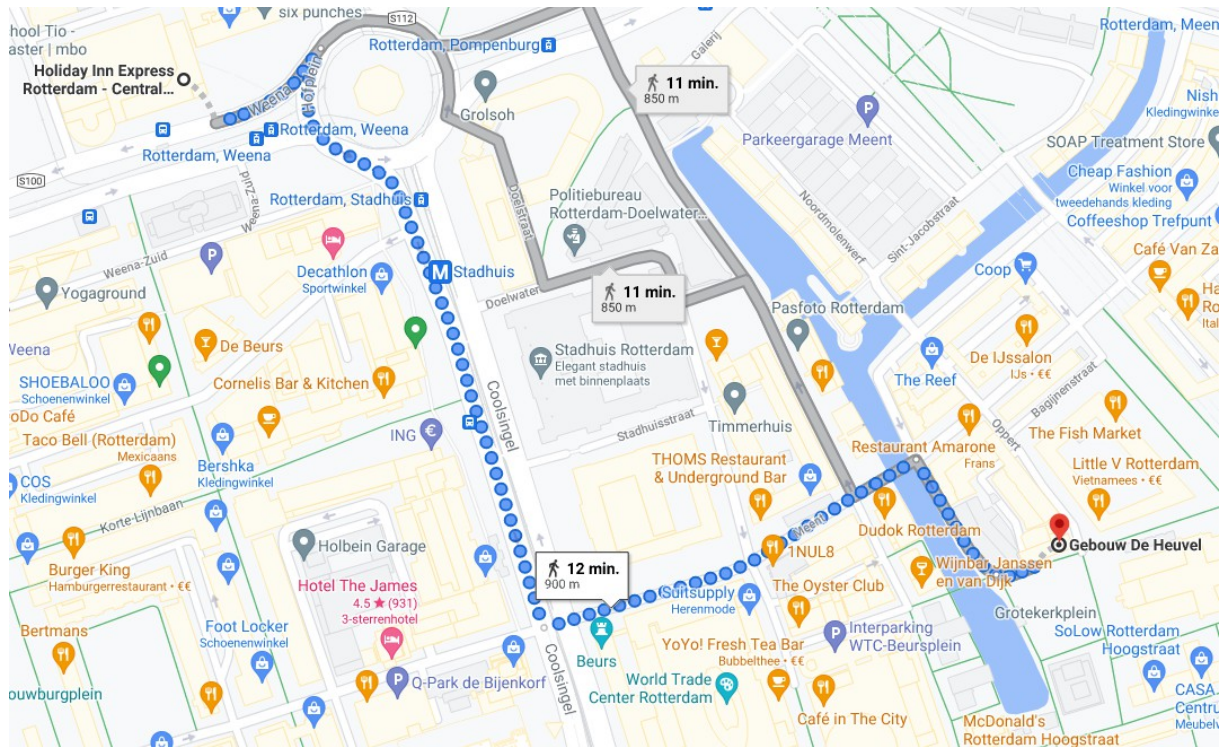
